

“P”= Parking for big rigs, the area known as “the slab” is the southern-most “P” on the map about halfway between entrances. There is water for horses there. For reference, the yellow loop is six miles. (It goes past a rifle range—caution, if in use it can be scary for some horses)

Brown dotted lines are known trails. Most are marked with white squares with a “1” on them. They may or may not be cleared and markers may be down in some areas. Use caution.

Pink line is the main road through Cherokee WMA. It is seven miles from Zeb to Qualls Rd. Jincy’s Kitchen Restaurant is at the Qualls Rd. entrance and is horse friendly. Cash only. Open Fri-Sun.

No riding in the dark green area at the bottom of the map. You must carry an Okla Hunting/Fishing license with you on trail. Rangers do check and there is a hefty fine if you do not have one. They can be purchased online for \$25 and are good for one year, all over Oklahoma in various state WMAs.
