"Come ride with us" in the beautiful Osage Hills in northeastern Oklahoma. The terrain consists of lakes and streams, sandy trails, woods, meadows and rocky hills.

The campsite is a 15-acre pasture, with trees and electric hook ups. Electric hook ups have been upgraded to 50 amp circuits and requires you to have a special adapter to use the electricity. Water is available, but we suggest you bring drinking water. There are two water faucets available in camp for watering and bathing your horse. Restrooms and hot showers are available in the large pavilion where meetings will be held depending on current temperature's. If temps are under 32 degrees the water will be off in the pavilion. Upon arrival, please wait for parking instructions if conditions are muddy.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Horses will be stationary tied to trailers. It's recommended that horses be securely shod. Smoking on the trail will be limited according to weather conditions. No motorcycles allowed. Dogs must be on a leash at all times.

Friday night supper provided to all workers. Saturday evening meal will be a pot luck meal, bring your favorite side dish and management will provide the meat. Lunch will be sandwich makings when you come off the trail furnished by management.

CHECK IN: Pre-ride examination by judges will begin at 3.00 pm Friday, 3 Nov. After parking, pick up rider packet & weigh in at the table in the pavilion. Original current negative Coggins papers must be presented on all horses in camp. Law requires current health papers at state line. Send a copy of Registration papers to compete for Breed Awards.

ENTRY FEES: Senior entry - \$90.00, Junior entry - \$65.00. Late fee after Oct 25 \$5.00. Family discount for 2 or more riders in immediate family - \$3.00 per rider. First 5 first-time competitors: \$10.00 discount. Camping fee - \$15.00 per horse. Electric fee - \$10.00 per night. See NATRC & REGION FOUR fees on entry form. Make checks payable to: INDIAN TERRITORY CTR. Mail entries to Ride Secretary. Cancellations after Oct 25 will be refunded less \$20.00. No-shows are not refunded.

DIRECTIONS: Hwy 97 north from Sand Springs dead ends at the John Zink Ranch (about 10 Miles). Camp is just inside the gate. From the EAST: take Hwy 51/64 out of Tulsa west to 129th W. Ave exit then north to ranch. From the WEST: arriving on Hwy 64 take 129th W. Ave exit north to ranch. Arriving from the west on I44 exit at Sapulpa onto Hwy 97 then north to Hwy 51/64 Then west one mile to 129th W. Ave then north to ranch.
