French Broad River to trails that take you through the vineyards. Sunday you will
have the opportunity to ride by the Biltmore House. Helmets required. If you wish to
arrive on Thursday or before, you must contact The Biltmore Barn 828-225-1454.
French Broad River is off limits to horses! No smoking on trails. No open fires.

Directions: GPS Address, 1 Lodge St. Asheville, NC 28803. From Interstate 40, use
exit 50. Follow signs to Biltmore Estate. Stay in Far Left Lane. From Interstate 26,
take the 1-40 E. Use exit 50, same as above. Entrance to the Estate is on the left.
Follow the sign "Horse Event" and BEC, camp is approx. 3 miles from the entrance
gate. Traffic is very slow on the estate and the geese always have the right of way.:)
